Annual Data Verification for National Report



Data verification hosted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT) is an annual event which involves representatives from all government ministries and non-government organizations.

Policy and Planning Division Principal Officer, Nuu Tautaiolevao and OIC of Stats and Media Unit, Sergeant Solomona Aimaasu were representing our ministry for this event.

The purpose of data verification is to ensure that data collected are as accurate as possible, and to minimize human and instrument errors - including those which arise during data processing. Data verification is an on-going process which should start at the data gathering stage, and continue during data entry and analysis.

Samoa Red Cross Society with the assistance of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) donated some goods for Tanumalala Prison as part of their support for COVID-19 while they celebrated 72 years since the Red Cross Society has been established. Detention facilities, which are overcrowded, suffer from poor hygiene or lack ventilation, pose an extra challenge when it comes to preventing and containing infectious diseases, including the <u>Coronavirus COVID-19</u>.
