The method and conditions of payment to be made to the supplier under this Contract shall be as follows:

Payment for Goods supplied from abroad:

Payment of foreign currency portion shall be made in *currency of the Contract Price* in the following manner:

- (i) **Advance Payment: *ten percent (10%)*** of the Contract Price shall be paid within thirty (30) days of signing of the Contract, and upon submission of claim and a bank guarantee for equivalent amount valid until the goods are delivered and in the form provided in the bidding documents or another form acceptable to the procuring entity.
- (ii) **On Shipment: *Forty percent (40%)*** percent of the Contract Price of the Goods shipped shall be paid through irrevocable confirmed letter of credit opened in favour of the Supplier, ([upon acceptance of the final Factory Acceptance Test for a period of 60 day] OR [30 days prior to notification of the shipping date, for a period of 60 days]), and upon submission of documents specified in GCC Clause 13. Any and all additional confirmation costs requested by the Supplier and/or the Advising Bank are to the account of the Supplier.
